Highlights from August Food Protection Trends



A study determines the ability of produce treatment technologies currently being marketed to consumers, along with chlorine bleach and running tap water, to remove E. coli O157:H7, L monocytogenes and Salmonella enterica inoculated onto specific vegetables. Another study finds that traditional approaches by retail food establishments in training employees on proper food handling practices need to be combined with new behavior-based approache that include food safety education as part of the culture of the organization. 

















